Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to the “Shri Lal Bhadur Shastri Samarak Govt. Ayurved College, Handia, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh” with 30 seats in UG (BAMS) Course for the academic session 2019-20 and to issue Letter of Permission to Increase in intake capacity in UG (BAMS) course from 30 to 60 seats from the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R.17011/199/2018-EP (IM-1) dated 27.07.2018 related to admission matter for the academic session 2018-19 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic year 2019-20.

2. Further, to refer application dated 30.08.2018 of the Principal, Shri Lal Bhadur Shastri Samarak Govt. Ayurved College, Handia, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh for seeking permission of the Central Govt. to increase in intake capacity in UG (BAMS) course from 30 to 60 seats from the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 which was forwarded to CCIM vide Ministry's letter dated 26.12.2018. Accordingly, the CCIM had visited the college on 21.02.2019 and as per the Ministry's letter dated 21.05.2019 the CCIM issued Letter of Intent to you vide Letter No.3-4/2019-Ay (16) , dated 10.06.2019 to increase admission capacity from 30 to 60 seats in existing UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

3. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution again on 12-13.06.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance of shortcomings informed by the CCIM under section 13A of IMCC Act, 1970 and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry vide letter dated 20.06.2019 related to permission for admission in existing UG (BAMS) 30 seats as well as for issuing/not issuing Letter of Permission to increase admission in existing UG (BAMS) course from 40 to 60 seats.
